On the cover: Where's the cover image? In this issue, *Cell* experiments with the use of Quick Response (QR) barcodes to create more interactive PDFs. We kick off the issue with a barcode linking to *Cell*'s first animated cover. To view the cover, download a barcode reader for your smartphone or tablet (e.g., i-nigma for iPhones and Androids) and then snap a picture of the cover. The app will link to an animated movie on the web. Can you find the 16 other QR barcodes in this issue?

The hidden animation on the cover shows circulating erythrocytes with two cells infected by malaria parasites from the genus *Plasmodium*. Intracellular parasites acquire nutrients via the plasmoidal surface anion channel (PSAC) on the host membrane. In this issue, Nguitragool et al. (pp. 665–677) identify a parasite gene family that is responsible for PSAC, unveiling a key target for future antimalarial drugs. Animation by Anita Mora and Austin Athman (RML, NIAID).
