

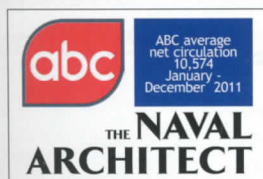

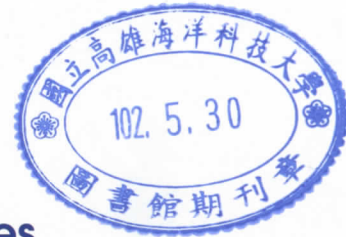
Front cover image: The Germanischer Lloyd-classed SWATH vessel *Skrunda*, pp12-15
